The New Dyfi Bridge

Plans have been backed to replace the 200-year-old Dyfi Bridge. The £46m Dyfi bridge project on the A487, north of Machynlleth, will improve transport links, according to the Welsh Government.

Expected to be completed by summer 2022, the controversial project includes the building of a viaduct across a wider floodplain as well as a river bridge. The planned work will also include traffic calming and improved drainage north of the 19th Century bridge to protect existing cottages, with a path for cyclists and walkers.

Transport Minister Ken Skates said the A487 was a key route, linking Gwynedd, Powys, Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire, and improvements would benefit the economy and tourism. "It is clear to me that action needs to be taken to improve this section of the A487 so that there is a safe and reliable route linking the communities around Machynlleth," he said.
