Great News-Aberdyfi Wharf Project is GO

Gwynedd Council has confirmed officially that the Aberdyfi harbour wharf re-construction/piling project has been given the green light, the budget is in place and the timetable is as follows:

- Tenders for the contract will be posted in January 2020
- Contractors appointed March 2010
- Public meeting to be arranged, in conjunction with ACC, during early summer 2020
- Work commences September 2020
- Completion March 2021
- Budget £3m

The project, an integral part of the Aberdyfi's flood defence, represents a significant and welcome investment in the village's infrastructure.

Its contribution to the long term future of Aberdyfi as key tourist attraction is significant.

Memorial Benches

A dedicated bench can make a fitting tribute or memorial to a loved one or be used to commemorate a special occasion such as a birth, birthday, wedding or anniversary. The responsibility for memorial benches in Aberdyfi has historically been with Gwynedd Council, but in the context of budget cuts (a familiar and unwelcome message) Aberdyfi Community Council has assumed that responsibility.

We have already installed two new benches on Seaview Terrace and they are a marked improvement on the old softwood models.


