The Health Watchdog Have Your Say

The North Wales Community Health Council (NWCHC) has confirmed dates for engagement events across the region, giving people the opportunity to share their views and experiences of major changes made in March of this year regarding the provision of vascular services.

Mr Geoff Ryall-Harvey, Chief Officer for NWCHC said 'Since the changes that have been made to some vascular services, we have been monitoring the patient experience of the service. Over recent months we have been aware of an increased level of concerns in respect of the impact of the service change.'

'The events will be structured around a number of aspects such as compliments, concerns and complaints, care planning, care provision and communication.'

The events will offer NHS staff, patients, their carers and their families to talk about Vascular Services
