Would you like to help make a **Memorial Quilt**

Theme: Love and Hope

The idea is that we each make a square 'block' which will be sewn together to make a quilt that will be donated to the community and displayed somewhere prominent.

What size? 6 inch square design with a little extra round the edge to enable us to sew all the blocks together, giving an overall size of 6.5—7 inches square.

You can make a block however you want— use a sewing machine, hand-sew, bondaweb, patchwork, applique or you could even draw or paint a design with fabric pens and paints!

Please wash whatever fabric you use before you start—this will ensure that when the final quilt gets washed, it will shrink evenly and not distort.

If you would like a piece of material to paint on, please get in touch and when you have completed your block, let us know and we'll arrange collection.
