RHODDIR DRWY HYN RYBUDD fod Cyngor Gwynedd yn bwriadu dim llai na saith niwrnod ar ôl dyddiad y rhybudd hwn wneud Gorchymyn fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw berson rhag peri i unrhyw gerbyd fynd mewn unrhyw gyfeiriad ar hyd y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd a adwaenir fel Copperhill Street, Aberdyfi am bwynt union gyferbyn a rhifau 9 a 10 Tai Newyddion, Copperhill Street, Aberdyfi.

Mae angen y Gorchymyn er galluogi gwaith cloddio ar hyd y ffordd oherwydd gwaith ar olau stryd diffygiol.

Y ffordd arall o bwynt gyferbyn a rhif 9 Tai Newyddion yw dilyn y ffordd mewn cyfeiriad de ddwyreiniol am bellter o oddeutu 230 metr hyd at ei gyffordd gyda Chapel Square ac yna troi i'r chwith. Dilyn y ffordd ac yna ymlaen i ddilyn Church Street am bellter o oddeutu 185 metr hyd at ei gyffordd gyda Balkan Hill. Troi i'r chwith, gan ddilyn Balkan Hill ymlaen am bellter o oddeutu 330 metr hyd at ei gyffordd gyda Mynydd Isaf ac yna troi i'r chwith. Dilyn Mynydd Isaf ymlaen am bellter o oddeutu 255 metr ac yna ymlaen i ddilyn Trem y Leri. Dilyn Trem y Leri am bellter o oddeutu 60 metr hyd at ei gyffordd gyda Copperhill Street, troi i'r chwith, ac yna ymlaen hyd at y caead.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar y 19eg o Ebrill, 2021 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod na fydd hwy na tri mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith y bwriedir ei wneud ar y ffordd, pa un bynnag fyddo gyntaf. Ar hyn o bryd disgwylir y gellir cwblhau'r gwaith o fewn tua 11 diwrnod.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
SECTION 14(1) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991**

**THE GWYNEDD COUNCIL
(CLOSURE OF COPPERHILL STREET, ABERDOVEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Gwynedd Council intend not less than seven days from the date hereof to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in either direction along that length of road known as Copperhill Street, Aberdovey for a point directly opposite nos. 9 and 10 Tai Newyddion, Copperhill Street, Aberdovey.

The Order is necessary on health and safety grounds to the public during excavation works due to a faulty street light.

The alternative route from a point opposite no. 9 Tai Newyddion is to follow the road in a south easterly direction for approximately 230 metres up to its junction with Chapel Square and then turn left. Follow the road ahead and continue on to Church Street for a distance of approximately 185 metres up to its junction with Balkan Hill. Turn left, following the road ahead along Balkan Hill for approximately 330 meters up to its junction with Mynydd Isaf and then turn left. Continue along Mynydd Isaf for approximately 255 metres and then proceed along Trem y Leri. Follow Trem y Leri for approximately 60 metres up to its junction with Copperhill Street, turn left, following the road up to its closure.

The Order comes into effect on the 19th April, 2021 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding three months or until the work which it is proposed to carry out on the road is completed, whichever is the earlier. At this stage it is anticipated that the work will be completed within approximately 11 days.
