\* Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2021.

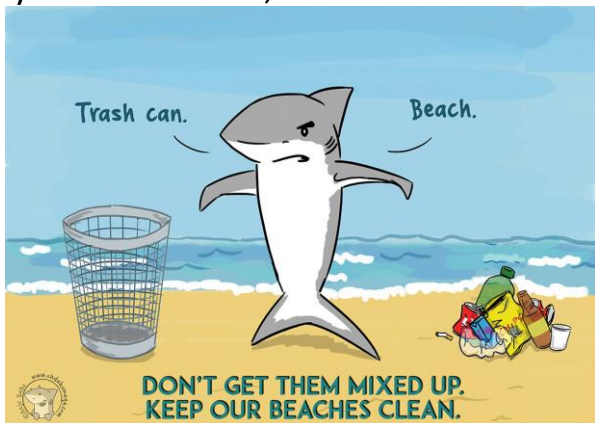
