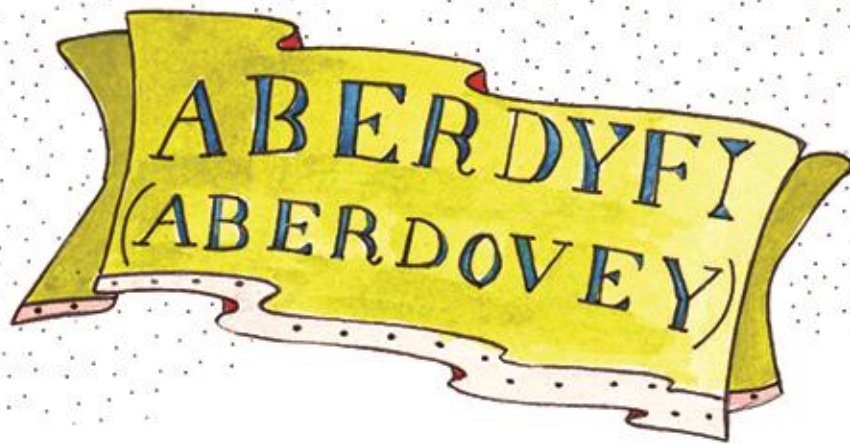

## Tree planting

As you may have noticed, the two trees in the playing field have now been cut down and one of them will be carved into an osprey at some point in the next few months.

DID YOU KNOW? There is a blanket tree preservation order for the whole of Aberdyfi, so you must get permission from Snowdonia National Park before cutting down any trees in the village, even if they are on your own property.
