

Queen's Jubilee celebrations

April 2022

The Queen's Jubilee celebrations are set to take place on 2nd - 5th June and various community events will be happening:

Aberdyfi

Thursday 9.45pm: Beacon lighting accompanied by church bells being rung at St. Peter's Church.

The beacon will be high on the hill behind the village and will be visible from the centre of the village and the beach.

Saturday, 10pm: Fireworks on the beach

Sunday, 12 noon: Pageant sail-past at the wharf, involving 70 boats of varying size and shape to celebrate 70 years of Her Majesty's reign.

Saturday 2pm: Carnival parade starting at Pendre Industrial Estate, ending at Cae Rhianfa.

Saturday 8am onwards: Car boot sale and carnival, Cae Rhianfa.

Aberdyfi Community Council are also buying a plaque from the Royal British Legion to celebrate the Queen's Green Canopy and also a commemorative bench, both of which will be in place within the next few weeks.

Things are still progressing with the project, although there have been a few unforeseen delays but it is hoped that we will have some definite information in the next few weeks.


Rubbish Plea


