

## Wolverhampton Bike Ride

The Wolverhampton to Aberdyfi Bike Ride returns this year on Friday 17th June 2022 following an absence of two years owing to Covid restrictions. The ride was established in 1993 it has evolved and expanded over the years with a view to raising as much money as possible for local charities in both Wolverhampton and Aberdyfi. Please note the event has a fixed date which is the third Friday in June each year.

The whole event is managed and run by volunteers. A total of £172,716.73 was raised in 2019. It is anticipated that this total will be surpassed this year! Over 500 riders have registered to ride.

An extract from rider's feedback best describes the day.

"The Dovey ride - challenging yet utterly rewarding. This isn't just your average velothon. You can tell it's been organised for cyclists, by cyclists.
