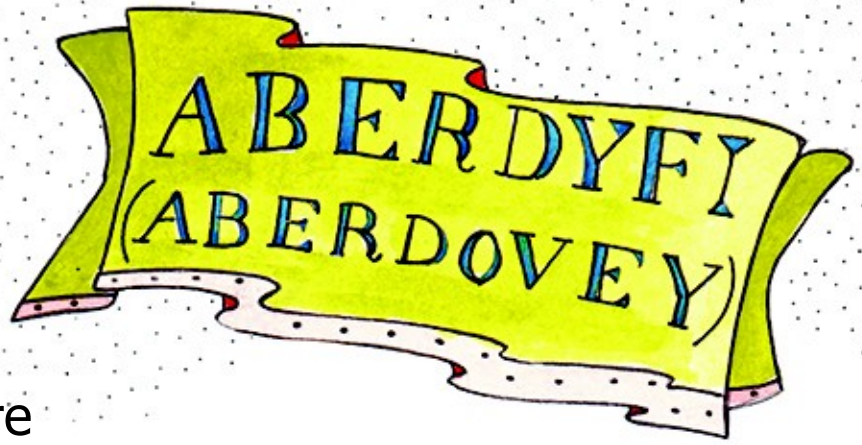

## Tywyn Health Centre

The current computer system will be replaced in August, so there will be major disruption at the health centre during this time.

### Key dates:

15<sup>th</sup> August: Computer system shut down and start of transfer of patient records to the new system

15<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> August:

\*Emergency appointments ONLY will be available

\*Emergency prescriptions ONLY which will be hand-written

\*No new registration of patients until after 31<sup>st</sup> August.

23<sup>rd</sup> August: New computer system goes live.

1<sup>st</sup> September: Normal services will resume

From the Health Centre:

"Whilst the EMIS installation is welcomed as a vast improvement on our previous patient record system, it will cause a high level of disruption throughout August. Our staff will have very limited access to computer records throughout, My Health Online patients will all be re-registered, all data will be recorded in handwritten form and transferred to the computer system once EMIS goes live on 23<sup>rd</sup> August.

The lack of computers will make every task significantly more lengthy and complicated for our staff so we ask that our patients please show understanding and patience towards our staff throughout this time. Training will take time and it will be a steep learning curve for the whole team post-installation."

## Wharf Development Project

### Key dates:

Mon 5<sup>th</sup> Sept: Contractors take over site

Mon 12<sup>th</sup> Sept: Work starts

Thurs 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept: Pile installation starts for approx. 6 weeks

May 2023: Anticipated project finish

The contractors will be using the whole of the boat park by the lifeboat station and an area that will be fenced off in the main car park.

There will be a lot of disruption over the first couple of months while the piles are being put in, but once this is done, smaller plant will be used for the rest of the work, so noise and disruption will be much less. There will be no public access to the jetty during the project, though the fishermen and Outward Bound will still have access. Work will be from approx. 7.30am – 6pm, Mon-Fri and 7.30pm-5pm Saturday.

Obviously this project will impact us all, but it is vital it is done as without it, the yacht club and the whole of the wharf area will fall into the sea.
