



Sewage concerns

Recently there has been some concern about human sewage being emptied into the estuary. The clerk has made enquiries and has been assured that this is not the case. The outlets near the jetty are storm drains, not sewage outlets, and these allow rainwater, not sewage, to run into the estuary when there is heavy rainfall. catchment area of the Dyfi estuary covers a huge area (see map) and matter from the land surrounding the tributaries gets washed into the estuary at high tides and times of heavy rainfall and this is the sewage seen in the Dyfi river.
