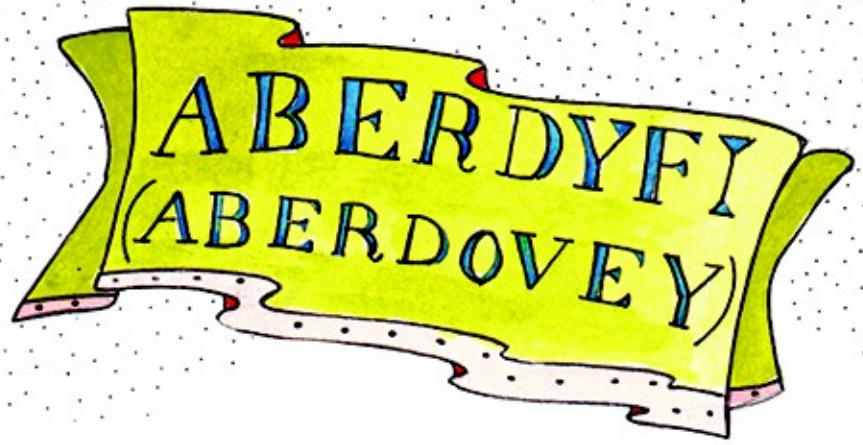

January road closure

We have had several complaints about the proposed road closure at Dyfi bridge in January. We have contacted Griffiths Ltd who have told us they have logged every complaint they have received and will be taking all of them to the Welsh Government. As they are under contract from the Welsh Government, they are unable to change anything without their approval. We have also been told that Griffiths Ltd plan to have a public meeting and we are waiting for a date. Apparently pipes need to be laid in the middle of the road which will be connected to the pumps by the cottages on this side of the bridge, to prevent flooding in this area. However, the new road needs to be finished first, so that vehicles can use that road instead of the one by the cottages, so if the new road is delayed, the road closure will also need to be delayed. We will advertise the public meeting as soon as we have a date.
